1 UNIFORM POLICY

Our school introduces a new uniform for all students, starting from the upcoming academic year (September 2025). This change follows careful consultation and is aimed at enhancing student comfort, promoting inclusivity, and reinforcing a strong sense of unity and identity within our school community.

1.1 Implementation and Transition Plan:

- For Class 1 students, the new uniform will be mandatory from the start of the 2025 academic year.
- For students in Classes 2 to 6, we are offering a one-year transition period. During this time, students in these classes may continue wearing the existing uniform if they prefer. However, please note that mixing elements of the old and new uniforms is not permitted.
- From the 2026 academic year onwards, the new uniform will be compulsory for all students.

1.2 Uniform Policy Enforcement:

- If a student is not in proper uniform, or their appearance is deemed unacceptable, they are sent to the Deputy Headmaster in charge of discipline and if not available, to one of the Headmasters or any available Head of Department as soon as possible.
- On the first offense, students will be sent home for the remainder of the day and must report to a Head of Department the following day to verify that they are wearing the correct uniform.
- Failure to report to any Head of Department, as instructed, will be considered a serious offense of insubordination and will be directly referred to the Discipline Committee.
- Repeated offenders are referred by the Deputy Headmaster to the Discipline Committee which will act based on the **Discipline Categories** available in the school's Discipline Policy.

1.3 Formal Uniform Requirements:

- Jacket (Blazer): Specially designed for The Grammar School. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Shirt**: White, plain, long sleeves with white buttons, featuring the embroidered Grammar School pocket logo. Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.

- **Boys' Trousers:** Beige, specially designed for The Grammar School. Available only at "<u>Victuar</u>" clothing shop.
- **Girls' Skorts:** Beige skort, specially designed for The Grammar School. Available only at "<u>Victuar</u>" clothing shop.
- Tie: Specially designed for the school. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- Shoes: White sneakers.

1.4 Casual Uniform Requirements:

- Anorak: Green Anorak specially designed for The Grammar School.
 Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Zip-up Jacket**: Green zip-up jacket specially designed for The Grammar School, with the school's logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Sweater**: Beige with the school logo, specially designed for The Grammar School. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Polo Shirt:** White, short sleeves for summer or long sleeves for winter, embroidered with The Grammar School logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- **Trousers**: Beige, specially designed for The Grammar School. (For both boys and girls) Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- **Bermudas:** Beige specially designed for the Grammar School. (Only for boys) Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- Girls' Skorts: Beige skort, specially designed for The Grammar School.
 Available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- Shoes: White sneakers

1.5 Physical Education Uniform Requirements:

- Puma Tracksuit with the school's logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- Puma T-Shirt with the school's logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.
- Puma Shorts with the school's logo. Available only at the School Bookstore.

• Training Shoes: No bright colours allowed.

1.6 Athletic Program Uniform

Physical education Uniform for Athletic Programme students differs from the above according to the Sport they register (Please check at the School's Bookstore)

1.7 Stem And Athletic Programme Students

Athletic and STEM programme students are entitled to a special designed zip-up jacket which will be provided to them by their teachers.

1.8 General Points on Appearance & Uniform:

- Class 7 Students:
 - Every **Friday**, they have permission to wear their custom GSL2026 black t-shirt (with a pre-approved design/logo).
 - No excessive makeup is allowed.
- **Hot Weather Uniform for Boys:** Beige shorts with the school logo, specially designed for The Grammar School, available only at "Victuar" clothing shop.
- Nails: Girls are allowed nails in pale colours (light grey, pink, beige) of reasonable length.
- Makeup: No Makeup is allowed
- **Boys' Grooming:** Boys must be clean-shaven and maintain tidy hair with no shaven designs or spikes. Longer hair must be above the collar at the back, above the eyebrow in the front, and not worn in a ponytail.
- **Jewellery:** Modest jewellery designed for the ears is permitted. A small set of dark coloured ear studs for boys is accepted. Other facial or visible body piercings, including tongue and nose piercings, are not allowed.
- **Hair:** The following is not permitted: Non-natural hair colours, highlighted hair, extensions, beaded additions
- **Clothing Restrictions:** Jeans, leggings, tight trousers, and boots are not allowed. Skirts and pants must be worn above the hipbone.
- **Cold Weather:** During extremely cold weather, students may wear extra layers <u>under</u> the long-sleeved white polo shirt and the zip-up jacket on top. Non-uniform items are not allowed at school.
